Now

- ❖ Some parents have been clear they do not want their child with a disability working (THEIR CHILDREN WANT JOBS)
- ❖ Need to find ways to support, empower, assist families in understanding the benefits of work.
- ❖ We have a list of people who want work and are on CIE provider lists waiting/working on getting employed.
- ❖ We need to identify all individuals who are not accounted for
- ❖ PUNS data can assist us in accessing info according to service preference.

BY 06/30/2010...

- ❖ We will identify all people in adult day & sheltered programs who wish to work in competitive employment AND they will be actively enrolled AND participating in CIE services.
- ❖ The last 25% will be receiving CIE services.

By 06/30/2007...

- ❖ We will identify the number of people in day & sheltered programs who want competitive employment, using any/all of the following means:
 - Survey/questionnaire
 - Existing data on numbers (collaborate with the data group)
 - Supports Coordinators
 - Training
- ❖ 10% increase in CIE services

BY 06/30/2008...

- ❖ 30% of people are receiving CIE services
- ❖ Support to families are increased expressing the value of employment
- ❖ Financial considerations (this will lead to more people working), etc...
- ❖ More people who were not interested in employment last year will see their peers working and will change their minds about work, thus increase the number of NEW people identified to work.
- ❖ No back-filling of “slots”

BY 06/30/2009...

- ❖ 30% increase of people are receiving CIE services
- ❖ Continue to support families as well as support staff to reach our goals
